I recently purchased the Response Tile dance floor from Sport Court Flooring (Calgary) for my studio. We have been open for 4 years now and were dancing on a slippery floor for the first 3 years. I chose the response tile floor as I knew it was a high quality, non-slippery floor.

We easily installed the new floor ourselves with help from a few family members and were done in only a couple of hours. The click-together feature of the Response Tile is wonderful for installation and the tiles were easy to cut to fit around corners and doorways.

The new floor was installed just prior to Tap & Jazz exams at our studio, and I immediately noticed a change in the dancing of my students. They were turning better and jumping higher. I attribute this to the confidence felt when dancing on a floor which is not slippery or too sticky. The floor has a nice spring to it to add to the dancers' elevation.

Our studio offers classes in Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Highland, Lyrical and Pointe and the new floor has proved to work well for all disciplines.
