Acceptable Uses for Sport Court Flooring

Sport Court floors are primarily for athletic purposes. It is <u>NOT</u> acceptable to use the flooring under the following circumstances. The warranty does NOT cover damage caused by negligence or unintended uses.

- Absolutely <u>NO</u> stiletto heel shoes, cleated shoes, or other footwear that may puncture the flooring. Street shoes should not be worn on the floor since pebbles can get stuck in the treads and puncture the floor.
- Tables and chairs <u>MUST</u> have proper casters under the legs. Do <u>NOT</u> drag tables, chairs, or other equipment across the floor.
- Heavy items on wheels such as amplifiers or musical equipment often have small wheels that will cause ruts in the flooring.
 Always put plywood over the floor to protect it from rolling loads on small wheels.

Sport Court floors are tough but they are not indestructible. Use common sense to keep your floors protected from damage. If you are not sure about something please call us.
