I am writing to say thank you for your assistance with our CIS National Men's Volleyball Championship in March.

The University of Alberta was the first Canadian University program to purchase a transportable Sport Court Volleyball playing surface some 8 years ago. Since that time, the floor has been part of many High School and Club Championships around the province as well as a key component to the five CIS Volleyball Championships hosted at the University of Alberta since its purchase.

The ease of set and take down has allowed us to not only make use of the surface here at the U of A, but it has also allowed us to share the floor with others. Its distinct two-colour Green and Gold finish ties into our programs colours well, and also highlights the playing surface adding to the overall atmosphere in our gymnasium. We have received comments from around the country regarding the floor's positive contribution to the seven Nation wide television broadcasts of CIS Championship games played in our building.
